Our Goal is to give back the voice to the voiceless, ensuring that all Jamaicans are treated as first class citizens with access to comfortable living conditions, affordable housing, good salaries, safety and security, quality healthcare, and free public education

The vision of the DDP is to establish a government that respects its boundaries and prioritize the needs and rights of the citizens, aiming for a caring leadership that fulfills the true promise of governance

Our Comprehensive 23 -Point Plan for Jamaica: (geared toward making the life of every citizen happy and comfortable in the shortest possible time frame)

1. Breaking JPS Monopoly

The current energy landscape in Jamaica has been predominantly shaped by the monopoly held by the Jamaica Public Service Company (JPS). While the company has played a significant role in providing electricity to the nation there is a pressing need to reevaluate the terms of its contract in order to address the detrimental impact it has had on consumers.
